Proposed new walking and cycling route for Kirton in Lindsey

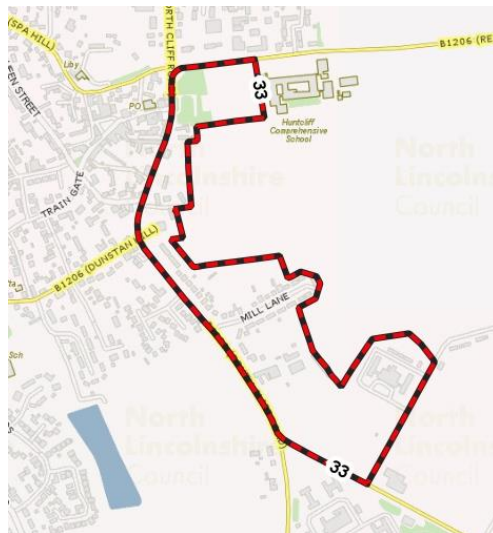
Kirton in Lindsey Town Council are currently working with both North Lincolnshire Council and the Ministry of Defence with the aim to secure the Vincent Hall (old RAF gym) for use as a community sports facility for Kirton in Lindsey.

As part of this work, improved walking and cycling access to the building is under consideration. As part of a wider scheme of proposed new and improved walking and cycling routes across North Lincolnshire, your views are sought on the proposal for a new route within Kirton in Lindsey.

NOTICE OF VACANCIES IN OFFICE OF PARISH COUNCILLOR

Parish of Kirton in Lindsey

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that due to the resignation of Cllr Cossey, a casual vacancy has arisen in the Office of Parish Councillor for the Parish.

If by Monday, 1 February 2021 (14 days* after the date of this notice), a request for an election to fill the said vacancy is made in writing to the Returning Officer at North Lincolnshire Council, Church Square House, 30-40 High Street, Scunthorpe, North Lincolnshire, DN15 6NL, signed by TEN electors for the said Kirton in Lindsey Parish, an election will be held to fill the said vacancy, otherwise the vacancies will be filled by co-option.

In accordance with current legislation where ten valid requests for a by-election are received by the Proper Officer then under the provisions of the Coronavirus Act 2020 and The Local Government and Police and Crime Commissioner (Coronavirus) (Postponement of Elections and Referendums) (England and Wales) Regulations 2020 the election will not take place, and the vacancy will be held open until it is filled at the Ordinary Election of Councillors due to be held on Thursday, 6th May 2021. However, this date may be brought forward or deferred by the Government depending upon the circumstances. Any Election that is in due course called will be duly publicised as required by law.
