

KIRTON IN LINDSEY TOWN COUNCIL PROMOTING KIRTON COMMITTEE MINUTES

Minutes of the meeting of Kirton in Lindsey Town Council Promoting Kirton Committee on Monday 21st March 2016 held at the Town Council offices, 84a South Cliff Road, Kirton in Lindsey at 7.30pm.

PK15/37 To receive apologies and reasons for absence

PK15/41 To discuss plans for restoration of the Parish Pump

M Hollingsworth showed the committee revised designs for the interpretation board, which were approved. It was agreed that the board would be fixed directly onto the rear of the pump and this could take place at the same time as restoration. The Clerk and M Hollingsworth would liaise on this.

PK15/42 To initiate planning for the 2016 Summer Gala

The Clerk had met with J Melling and they had made an initial list of local groups to be contacted and what activities they would be asked to do. No further volunteers had come forward to assist. It was agreed that the gala should be kept simple and traditional. It was agreed that if a suitable response had not been received by local groups by the May meeting the gala would be scrapped. The Clerk would continue to work with J Melling on the arrangements.

PK15/43 To receive a report from the Bloom Group on plans for Kirton in Bloom

The group reported that they had met and agreed classes for the Kirton in Bloom competition and produced entry forms which would be in the next Kirton First. It had been decided to enter EMIB next year but try the BKV competition this year. The windmill had indicated he would be happy to work with the school on planting up some tubs and the primary school were also happy to be involved. They had requested a donation of £50 to assist in purchasing tubs and flowers, the Clerk would add this to the full council payments for approval.

Resolved to approve the design with a few alterations, the Clerk would then arrange distribution.
