Public Participation: Members of the public discussed their suggestions for a homecoming celebration event to celebrate Victoria Rumary's bronze medal win in Archery W1 at the Tokyo 2020 Paralympic games. Suggestions and requests included the use of KLASSIC Park on Sunday 19th October between 2pm and 5pm for a meet-and-greet with Victoria. Refreshments of drinks and biscuits to be made available. Kirton in Lindsey Archery Club to be present with practice sessions and Have-A-Go sessions available. The Archery Club suggested joint funding for costs alongside the Town Council.
