The Committee received the 2nd Quarter Budget Monitoring Report and discussed recommendations to Full Council and matters for consideration for 2026-2027 budget planning works. Items noted for budget planning works were assets/maintenance budget (including new equipment such as CCTV), allotments, SportsZone, staffing (travel expenses etc) and annual town meeting refreshments cost. The Committee discussed the events budgets including the Gala and contribution received from the circus.
